- Friday, April 13th

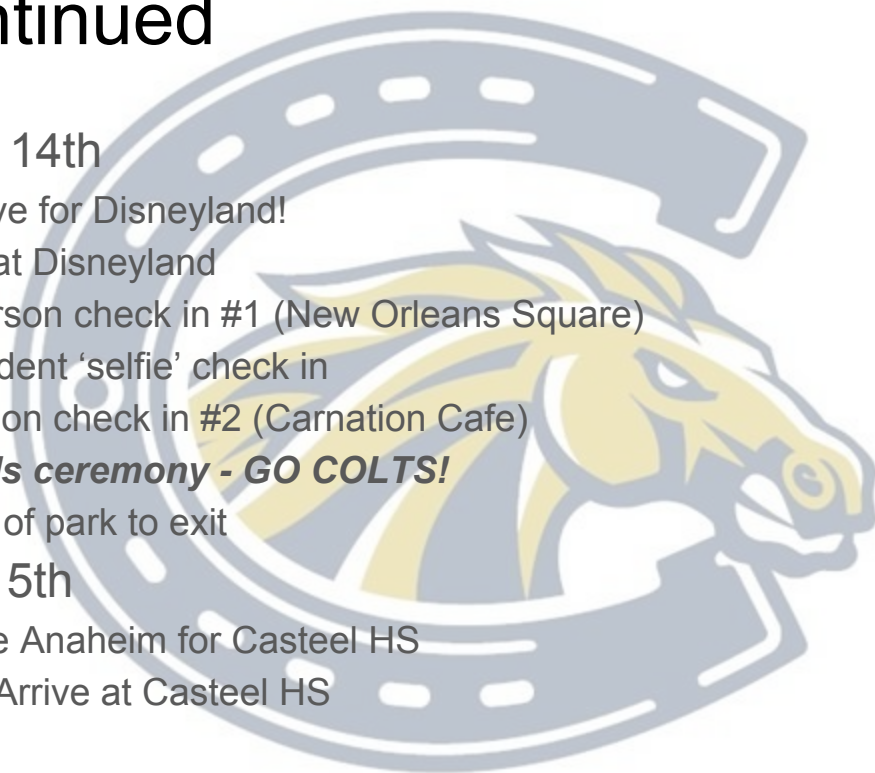
- Breakfast (included in trip)

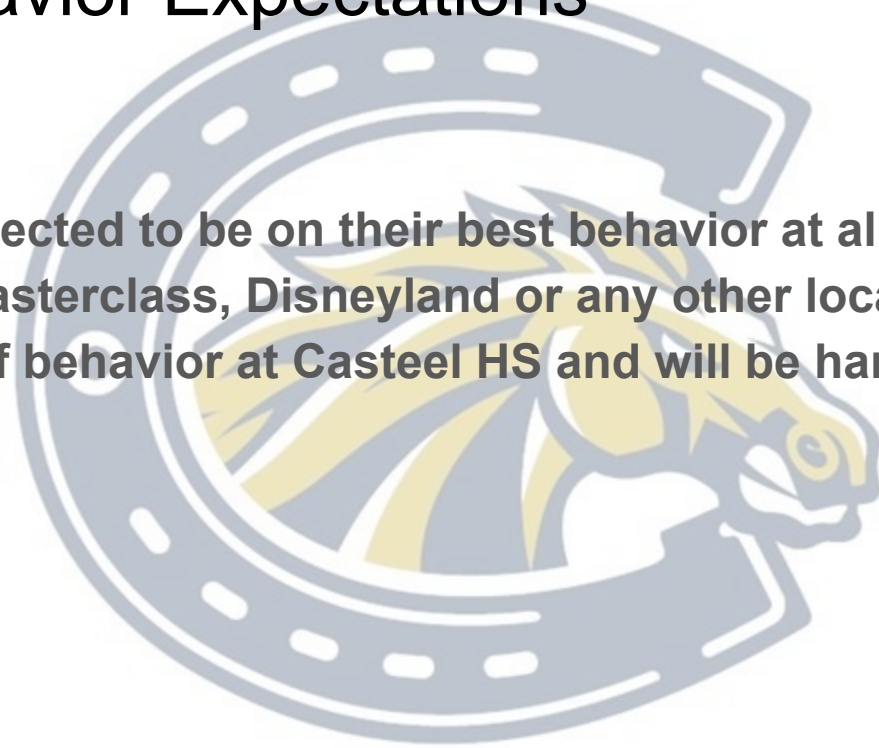
- Saturday, April 14th

Hotel Information

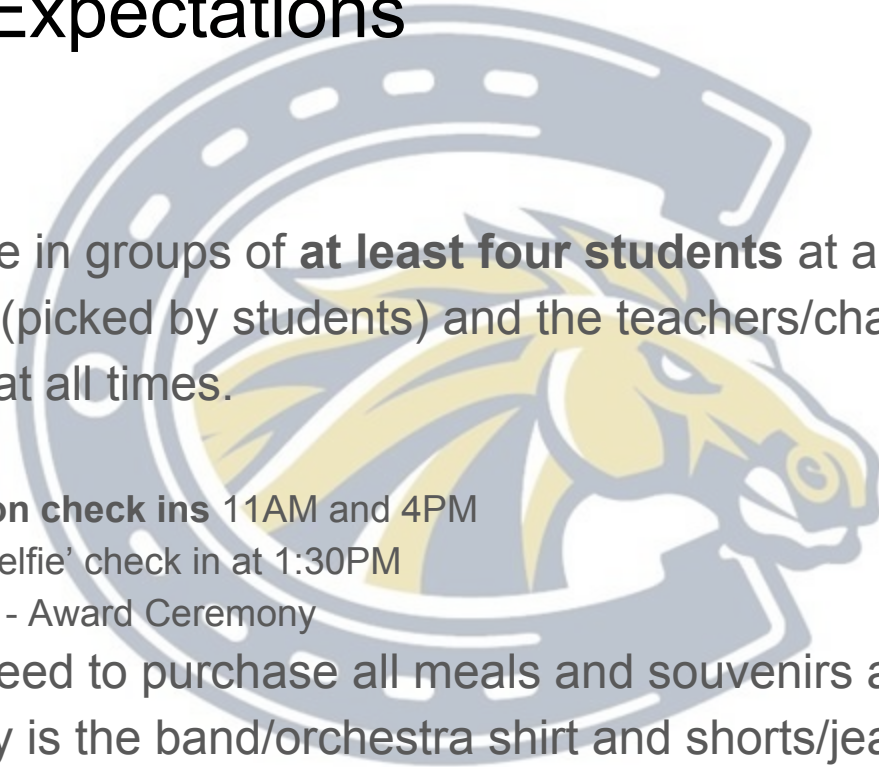
Staying at:

- Boys and girls will be housed separately and WILL NOT go in any other room that is not theirs. Even rooms of the same gender. Students will hang out in common areas or lobby.
- Students will be with their own age group (junior high, high school)
- Chaperones will do room checks at lights out. All students must be present and accounted for. No leaving room until 6AM - even for ice!

Disneyland Expectations

- Students will be in groups of **at least four students** at all times. Students will have a **buddy** (picked by students) and the teachers/chaperones will have a list of buddies at all times.
- Check ins:
 - Two **in person check ins** 11AM and 4PM
 - Cell phone 'selfie' check in at 1:30PM
 - Late evening - Award Ceremony
- Students will need to purchase all meals and souvenirs at Disneyland
- Disneyland day is the band/orchestra shirt and shorts/jeans.



Behavior Policies

Any behavior infraction deemed **extreme and serious** will be dealt with at the teacher's discretion.
All decisions made by teachers are final.

ZERO TOLERANCE Examples:

- Other genders in non-assigned rooms (boys in girls' rooms, etc.).

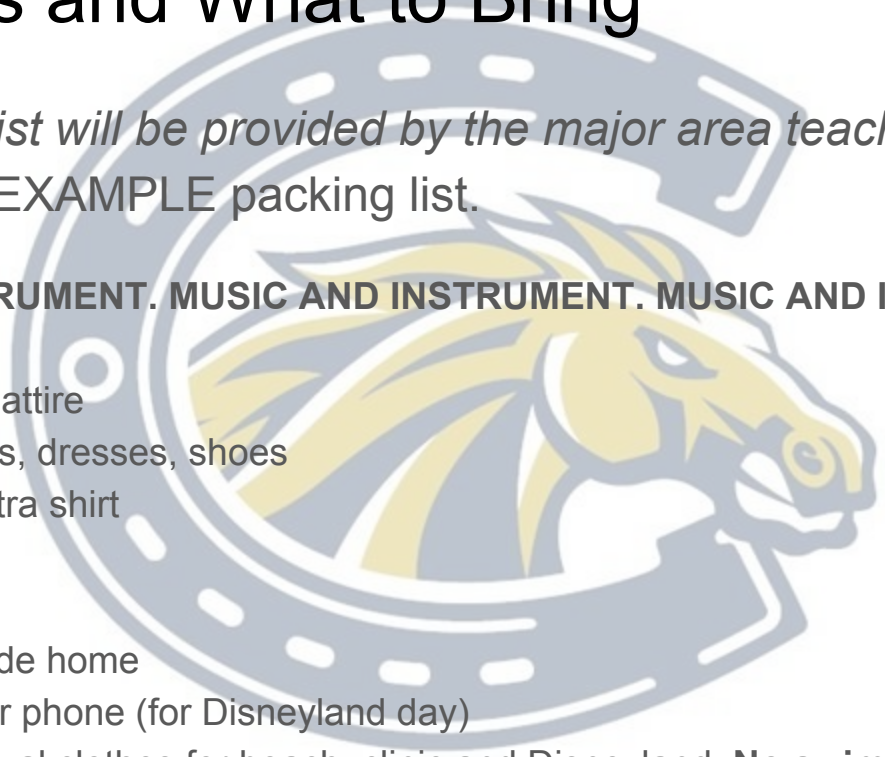
